I have submitted numerous complaints to the NYS Justice Center, Office of Mental Health, NYS Office of Professions and The Office of Medicaid regarding events that have happened at BryLin Hospitals. I have even made a complaint to your office.

I had an opportunity to mention my concerns of false claims at BryLin to US Attorney Trini Ross. She encouraged me to file a complaint with the FBI and OIG. My question to her was Do federal mandates have equal protection under the Law?

1. My employer Brylin Hospitals diverted thousands of incentive dollar's from the HITECH Act. EHR Incentive dollars went to the suburbs and not to the city hospital. I made a formal complaint with OMIG Staci McGowan is the contact person.

2. Patients have been directly harmed as a result of no electronic charting computers. Everything is on paper.

Patients have had parts of the chart missing. This caused a patient to receive a medical treatment that the medical doctor did not recommend.

3. Bridget Federico worked at BryLin Hospitals for almost a year and she was never an RN. She was involved in a medication error that sent a patient to the hospital.

I am tired and I can no longer continue to see patients harmed. Every day I work I put my license in jeopardy.
